

SELF(Strengthening Early Learning for Families) Term 3, July, August, September, 2019

SELF is a seven-week early intervention therapy program. It is designed for parents of young children up to the age of 5 years, who have difficulties with interacting, playing and communicating. This includes children with autism and other developmental delays. SELF provides a really effective way for parents to be supported to understand their child's unique strengths and challenges and to learn ways through play and their interactive relationship with their child to help them make gains. SELF has had a 100% high recommendation rating for the parents who have participated to date.

What is the SELF program?

- This program uses an evidence based approach which is developmentally and relationship focused.
- It is for parents of children who have difficulty interacting, playing and communicating.
- The program is held for 7 weeks 1 session per week
- It is facilitated by a specialist early intervention Occupational therapist and Speech and language Pathologist who work together to help parents gain a holistic understanding of their child.
- It is a combination of parent training and individual parent-child sessions.
- Parents will be 'coached' to play and interact through direct feedback and confidential video recording.
- There will also be roundtable discussion and sharing with other parents attending the program.

The following questions will be addressed:

- What kind of play promotes my child's attention and interaction?
- How can I get my child to play with me not just on his/her own?
- How can I 'read' my child's attempts to communicate?
- How do I keep interaction and communication going - and growing?
- What developmental skills should be focused on for my child.?

Venue: All sessions are conducted at Sensory Connections—104 Keightley Road West, Shenton Park

Application Process:

- There is space for five families for each SELF program.
- Two adult places are available per family.
- As there is a large investment in this program from therapists and funders there is a need a commitment for attendance to all sessions.

SELF (Strengthening Early Learning for Families) Program

Service Fees:

Parent Child Therapy Consultation – Senior Occupational Therapy x 4 at \$180 / session = \$720.00

Parent Child Therapy Consultation – Senior Speech and Language x 4 at \$180 / session = \$720.00

Parent Only Therapy Consults x 7.5 hours (* no charge) = \$0.00

Therapist Video Preparation and admin costs / family x 4 hours (*no charge) = \$0.00

Total Fee: \$1420.00

Parents can use Medicare rebates, private health insurance, and / or NDIS funding.

- Once we offer your child a place in this program, a deposit of 25% of the program fee will confirm your child's registration.
- The balance of the fee is due before the commencement date
- Cancellation of enrolment less than 2 weeks prior to the program commencement will incur a charge of 25% of the full program fee.
